Level 1/Beginner : for students who have little or no experience. Students with experience can opt to test out of this level. Student must know how to walk, trot, turn, stop and ride a pattern with control.
Level 2: Introduces lateral movements including disengaging and sideways, and cantering.
Level 3: Refining 1 & 2 skills, turn on haunches .

All levels include ground work skills.
