- Child learns basic riding skills
- Excellent for child's focus, balance, and coordination.

Parents:

One parent or assigned guardian will be in charge of the horse your child will be riding. Lead Line classes will incorporate teaching in the following areas: Grooming, Leading the horse, learning how to keep the horse out of your space, and leading the horse while your child is learning riding skills. Adult will be taught and instructed on the horse handling using our gentlest horses, so you do not have to have horse experience! Students will interact with each other by playing games on horseback. Please dress in layers and closed toed shoes. (Tennis shoes are fine).
